# Ref. No: 23/05203/TPO - Mill View Common Road Stock Ingatestone Essex CM4 9LY

Remove deadwood 30mm, prune lateral spread to the northeast over the rear garden of 4 Myln Meadow by approximately 1.5 metres and prune lateral spread of lower limbs to the southwest over the rear garden of The Oaks by approximately 3 metres to create clearance from the rear elevation of the dwelling.Reason: To maintain the tree within its current location.

# Ref. No: 23/01522/FUL - 4 Stock Lodge 60 High Street Stock Ingatestone Essex CM4 9BS

Demolish existing walls and pillars and construct replacement with wider access. Installation of new electric gate. Replace driveway surface with gravel
